Julie moved from the UK to South Africa in 1981 and began her teaching career in Radiography in 1982 at the Johannesburg Hospital. She subsequently moved to Baragwaneth Hospital in Soweto in 1985 before returning to the Johannesburg Hospital in 1991 as the Principal of the School of Radiography.

In 2002 Julie relocated to Zambia where she became the education coordinator between Philips Medical Systems in Zambia, the Zambian Ministry of Health and Fontys International Projects in The Netherlands for an ORET hospital rehabilitation project involving 71 hospitals.

2004 brought about change again for Julie and her family when they moved to Eindhoven in The Netherlands. In March 2006 she continued her relationship with Fontys and joined the Fontys International Health Projects / MeduProf-S team. Julie's primary responsibilities include the establishment and co-ordination of the departmental website, the development of Medical Imaging e-Learning courses, design of promotional materials, and the co-ordination and implementation of health training courses in Zambia and Uganda.
